Summary: At Hand is aimed to educate the public on how, in times of need, to identify and access available services within the NYC community. This series brings awareness to available services in the community by highlighting community service provider organizations addressing such issues as substance abuse, HIV/AIDS, mental health, and civic responsibility. Each episode will expose the viewers to what services are available "at hand" and how to access those services, in their local community, in their time of need.

Episode

Summary: *Serosorting As A Harm Reduction Model* This episode of "At Hand" puts the spotlight on Serosorting, a controversial harm reduction strategy. This sequence will be edited to include an introduction to the show and to the topic of discussion, the Harm Reduction Coalition will outline the principals of the harm reduction model in an interview, Robert Sandor (serosorting advocate) will make a presentation supporting serosorting as a sound harm reduction strategy in an interview. Followed by a commentary clip to close the show.

Taping: The HRC presentation and interview will be taped first. Then, Mr. Sandor will have an opportunity to view the HRC presentation, interview, and make his own presentation regarding serosorting. Each presentation should not run longer than 10 minutes.
